

What Is That Brake Noise I Hear?

hen it occurs, brake noise may be extremely irritating. However, some sounds are a very normal part of brake operation, while others may indicate a problem. How can you tell when noises from your vehicle's brakes are something to ignore or a problem that needs attention? Let's try to clarify some of these.

Things to observe:

Where does the brake noise seem to originate from? At what speed does the noise occur? Does it happen



A bit of history first. Environmental concerns with asbestos prompted automobile manufacturers to switch to semi-metallic brake linings, which provided excellent brake performance. However, because of the metal-to-metal contact between semi-metallic pads and the brake rotor, these pads often produced more noise than pads with asbestos or organic linings. Since the introduction of ceramic brake materials which are a more

a continuous audible noise, present when driving but disappears when braking, then the pads probably need to be replaced.

Grinding noise – This noise may occur during the first few stops due to the formation of surface corrosion on the brake rotor facings. If the noise disappears after a few stops, it does not indicate a problem. If it does not disappear or the brake pedal pulsates as you apply the brakes you should have your brakes inspected right away.

Trace squeak/squeal noise – Some brake linings may emit a soft squeak or squeal noise at medium speeds under light-to-medium braking. It may occasionally occur during the first few stops with cold brakes (especially in the morning), or in conditions of rain or high humidity.

Groan noise –. It is perfectly normal for some ABS systems to make a groaning noise when the ABS is activated. On some vehicles equipped with automatic transmissions, a slight groan may be heard from the brakes just as the vehicle comes to a complete stop or when allowing the vehicle to creep forward slowly from a stop.

ABS self-check – If you hear a small click and feel slight brake pedal movement when first starting to drive (at 5-10 kilometers per hour), this is most likely the Anti-Lock Braking system properly performing a system self- check to ensure that the system is functioning properly.

Another thing to note is if the ABS activates every time or intermittently on a dry road on a normal gradual stop this is not normal. This is usually the result of a faulty wheel speed sensor requiring replacement or service. If your vehicle develops brake noise, and you feel unsure about what it means, you should always take it to a qualified shop for an inspection and accurate diagnosis of your vehicle's brake system. Be aware of the various qualities and types of brake lining, drums and rotors that are available for your vehicle. While less costly brake components may provide satisfactory braking performance, the consequences may be noisy brake operation along with shorter brake life or the cursed black brake dust accumulating on your nice clean alloy wheels.

superior product, but also are more costly (be aware that there are different qualities of ceramics).

One may think any noise they hear indicates a problem with the braking system. A certain amount of noise from brake components is not unusual. The following are generally considered characteristic of all braking systems. These noises do not generally indicate any malfunction of the braking system or improper operation, but may indicate it is time to perform normal brake service.

Using RRSPs as a down payment? What you need to know

re you a first time home buyer and looking to use your RRSPs as a down payment? Here's a few things you need to know:

- 1. To use this program you must have not owned a home in the last 4 years but did you know that if your spouse owned a home previously and you didn't live in the house then you may still qualify.
- 2. RRSP contributions need to be in the RRSP account for at least 90 days before they can be used. If you are a monthly contributor to the account then only the amounts there for more than 90 days can be used for down payment.
- 3. You can borrow money to put into an RRSP and have it be there 90 days to use for down payment. Using this method of acquiring the RRSP means that you must be sure of two things, one being that

the lender is ok with you taking it out in 90 days. Secondly that it isn't put into an account that will not have fees to take the money out, money market funds or simple 90 day term certificates shouldn't cost you any penalty.

4. You can withdraw up to \$35,000 dollars from your RRSP to put down on a home. Locked in LIRA's are not eligible for this program so make sure before you start down this path that you know what type of account you have your money located

in at the bank.

5. You have to pay the amount you borrowed back to the RRSP account over the next 15 years. If you took \$15,000 dollars out you would need to repay \$1,000 a year to the account. Failing to pay this money back may result in CRA taxing it as income.

The government recently announced a program to provide first time buyers with an interest free loan, up to 5% of the purchase price (10% for new homes) that can be used to increase the total down payment, in addition to the 5% down from the purchaser. There are no payments required, but the loan must be repaid when the house sells. There are rules for the maximum house price and income limits so call me to discuss.



Effluent filters are mandatory in Ontario

ave a cottage? Or maybe you live in a rural area or small community. You'll have to deal with a septic system. Knowing how your septic system works is a must.

Think about this: all household wastewater exits your home through an underground pipe that leads to a buried septic tank. The waste flows to the first compartment of the tank where the heavy solids settle and the lighter materials like fats, oils and grease float to the top as scum. This scum is removed when the tank is pumped during regular maintenance.

On newer systems, any remaining organic material is trapped on a screen called the effluent filter located at the outlet of the tank (after 2008, effluent filters became mandatory on all installations and upgrades in Ontario).



The Federal Home Accessibility Tax Credit

The Home Accessibility Tax Credit (HATC) was first introduced in the Federal 2015 Budget, received Royal Assent in June of 2015 as is now law. It is a non-refundable tax credit and is Federal only so provides a maximum tax savings of 15% on qualifying expenses of up to \$10,000 (maximum tax savings of \$1,500). The HATC must be claimed by a qualifying individual or an eligible individual.

A qualifying individual is someone who is 65 years or older before the end of the taxation year or who is eligible to claim the disability tax credit. An eligible individual includes a spouse, common-law partner and certain supporting relatives of a qualifying individual. Home renovation expenses qualify for the credit if they are of an enduring nature and allow the qualifying individual to gain access to, or to be mobile or function with the eligible dwelling or reduce the risk of harm to the qualifying individual within the eligible dwelling or in gaining access to the dwelling. An eligible dwelling is the principal residence of the qualifying individual or of an eligible individual who ordinarily lives in that residence.


In a recent Tax Court case, Patrie v The Queen (2019 TCC 276), the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) took issue with a claim for a new deck that cost over \$11,000 on the basis that such renovations do not meet the requirements in the definition of a qualified renovation. The CRA argued the new deck was not of an enduring and integral character to the house, and that Mrs. Patrie's accessibility and mobility in or around the house



was not sufficiently assisted through the renovations. The Court analyzed the facts and found that Mrs. Patrie's mobility was worsening, the previous deck was over 18 years old and in rickety shape which restricted Mrs. Patrie's ability to access her garden and kitchen entrance to her home. The Court ruled that the expenses did qualify for the credit and ordered the CRA to reinstate the credit for Mrs. Patrie.











uffled sounds. Muffled voices. Perhaps over the winter months your hearing aids have gotten to sound a little dull. Naturally, you're frustrated. Maybe you even put your hearing aids away in a drawer because they stopped working for you. Don't give up on your hearing! This is a great time of year for a "Spring Cleaning" of your hearing aids.

Here are a few "At-Home" tips for cleaning and maintaining your Hearing Aids:

- Cleaning agents like "Rubbing" Alcohol can damage or weaken the shell. Use only a soft, dry cloth or tissue to gently clean the instruments whenever they are removed from your ears.
- Remove any accumulated cerumen (the clinical name for "earwax") daily. If using a cerumen removal tool, for example a "wax-loop" (the small tool with a curved metal wire on the end of a black handle) or a brush, always clean the instrument from below. The will prevent particles of wax or dirt from falling back inside the instrument.
- If the sound of your instrument becomes weak, it is likely that the wax-guard, microphones or sound outlet are blocked with cerumen (earwax). Either replace the wax filter or ask the professionals at Ward Hearing Centre for advice on corrective action. (Often, Brian can provide you with wax-guard replacements free of charge, even if you didn't initially receive your hearing instruments from him).
- The microphone inlets are less than 1mm wide and can easily become blocked if handled incorrectly. To prevent debris from entering the microphones and sound outlet on your hearing aids, ensure your fingers are clean and dry before handling them.

Brian says "it's important to remember that, while at home, day-to-day maintenance will ensure your hearing aids work properly every day, you still need to benefit from an in-office cleaning service that provides the in-depth cleaning that only a Hearing Professional can give."

Remember, "An unaided hearing loss is far more noticeable than a hearing aid."
